

Davide Paleari began studying piano under the direction of M° Massimiliano Nalesso, and continued in the piano class of M° Andrea Rucli at the Giacomo Puccini Music Institute in Gallarate (Varese).

After completing his secondary school studies at “Liceo Classico Ernesto Cairoli” in Varese, he entered the organ class of M° Emanuele Vianelli at the Malipiero Civic Music School in Varese. In 2011 he brilliantly graduated in organ and organ composition at the Conservatory in Como.

In 2014 he got the “*Master of Arts HES-SO en Interprétation musicale avec orientation en Concert*” by the Haute Ecole de Musique in Geneva in the organ class of M° Alessio Corti.

He attended organ performance courses held by M° E. Vianelli, M° E. Viccardi, M° A. Falcioni, M° L. Rogg and M° K. Schnorr. During the first organ festival named “Sardinia Organ Fest”, he took part in the playing of the 6 sonatas by Mendelssohn.

He usually gives concerts as organ player and also accompanies other instruments players and choirs such as the “Santa Maria del Monte” Choir from Varese, the “VerdeMar” Choir from Milan, the Chamber Music Choir of the Civic Music School of Varese, the Choir of the Camille Saint-Saëns Music Academy of Crosio della Valle (Varese), the “Antiqua Laus” Vocal Group, the Music Chapel of the Milan Cathedral.

In July 2013 he was invited to give some concerts in Canada, in the Saints-Martyrs-Canadiens Church in Québec and in the Saint-Stanislas Church in Trois-Rivières.

In February 2014 he was granted a scholarship by the Committee for the memory of Lino Conti, Maestro and Choir Director from Varese.

He gave concerts during various organ festivals, such as “Ancient Organs of the Varese District” , “Les Concerts de la Cathédrale Saint-Pierre de Genève”, “Fête de la Musique de Genève”, “September of Music in Riva San Vitale (CH)”, “Organ Vespers in the San Vittore Basilica in Varese”, “Organ Vespers in the Brunella Church in Varese”, “Organorum concentus” festival in Pinerolo (Turin), “September of Music in Santuario di Santa Maria dei Miracoli, Morbio Inferiore (CH)”.

In 2015 he was invited to give two concerts for the Opera Omnia of D. Buxtehude in Varese.

He works as organ player by the San Vittore Basilica in Varese and the S. Antonio from Padua Church of Brunella in Varese.

He is the Director of the Schola Cantorum of the S. Alessandro Church in Albizzate (Varese).

Since 2014 he has been teaching organ and music reading by the “Pontificio Istituto Ambrosiano di Musica Sacra” (Ambrosian Papal Institute of Sacred Music) in Milan.
